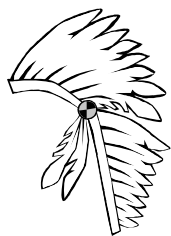
Easter has come and gone and it is so great to know that we serve a risen Savior. Our Easter celebration, here at Missionary Chapel, started at 8:00 AM at the Coronado Park where we had a delightful service with 112 in attendance. This was followed by a pancake breakfast and in the early afternoon we had even more come out to the park for our all day celebration. Altogether around 140 people were ministered to and it was simply a glorious day. We played volleyball and mush ball (a little larger than a soft ball and softer). Of course we can't have a gathering without food. Our ministries are flourishing, the food ministry helps at least 50-60 families a week, and we are gathering many supplies for the clinic at Aconchi.

Good things are happening in all the ongoing ministries. The work in Parker is excited as they are about to construct a new building on the site. This is the building that was originally purchased for Salt River. We had it moved out there to be used so that it would not go to waste. Due to the passing away of Pastor Johnson Begay and the circumstances beyond our control in not receiving a permit the Salt River church has had to be closed. However, Pastor Barbara is planning to have a cottage ministry starting soon from her home.

We don't talk much about finances in our letters but this once I want to thank all of you who are our supporters for your sacrificial giving. However, I feel that all our supporters should know that since Earl passed away we have lost much of our support. Due to this down turn in funding we have all taken a 10% cut in pay and to be quite honest we are receiving about 1/3 of the necessary funding to make ends meet. We are depleting our savings and we have cut costs as best we can. We do desire your prayers as we continue to fund all the ministries in the future. I am personally trying to get a part time job to raise a few funds for my family. We are truly excited about all that God is doing. We just got a couple of new families into church and God is working on them. I am not discouraged, this is not my work it is God's and we know that He is able to provide for it. I know that all of you have felt the effects of the economy that we are living in as well. So, I am asking that you would make this a priority in your prayers for us because we know that God is REALLY blessing our ministries. As to what God wants ... we walk by faith!
