Dear Friends,

There have been incredible things going on here at the Mission. We have taken on added responsibility in Mexico since the Veaches have stopped working with us. Pray for us to be able to keep up with things and that I will use wisdom in finding a new leader for that ministry. We are looking for someone from the area. We presently have about 4 people who would like to be the pastors for Aconchi and Las Delicias. My problem is; do they want to lead for financial gain or for the winning of souls? So meanwhile I get to preach every other weekend in Mexico. Quite honestly I enjoy it, but it does take a lot of extra time and energy.

This week I went to Mexico and left at 5:00 A.M. It is about a 6 hours drive. I went to Las Delicias called on homes for a couple hours in preparation for service on Saturday evening. From there I went to Aconchi and did the same thing for inviting people to the services on Sunday Morning. I then took care of some business and rested for about 30 minutes. Then it was time for service in Las Delicias. So, I returned and God helped us have a wonderful time of worship. I got back to Aconchi to my room at about 10:30 P.M. and fell into bed. I awoke freshened on Sunday morning. We had a very good time with the church members in Aconchi. While we were in that service we were invited to go to Sinoquipe a, a nearby village, WHERE I WAS INVITED TO have another service! Which I gladly did. They want us to start holding services there and already have a church building but no leadership. Pray for me because it seems like we are being asked to open more churches than we have people trained and I'm just one person. God is able to send us some people of God to fill these. I then returned home about 9:00 P.M. on Sunday.

We also were asked to go to another town further south to hold services. It is in the hometown of one of our church members in Phoenix. She said that they have a nice church building and a parsonage already but no pastor. The needs are great.

We just finished an awesome camp and praise God we ended up in the black. We are also looking at property for a camp in Yavapai County. The camp that we rent is charging us close to \$10,000.00 for 2 days of camp. That is a lot of money for us to raise every year. We feel we would be better served if we were able to have a place for meetings year round. This adds to all of the excitement of ministry work. We have long needed a year round place for meetings. Our churches are all quite small for large gatherings and we need to have more time together as a cohesive group. If you would like to donate to this it would be much appreciated.

Brian is out visiting our supporting churches in Missouri, Illinois and Indiana. He will be gone for 5 weeks and then we swap out and I will visit our supporting churches in Ohio, Kentucky and West Virginia. We need your prayers as our vehicles are in sore need of renovation and finances have been down. So please pray that we have successful deputation trips. Please pray for our protection as we drive.

We can thankfully say that many have received Christ recently and several of our youth feel the call of God to go to Bible School. Also, several from Parker want me to start our Mobile Bible Institute there. This is something we have wanted to do for the last year but haven't had enough interest yet. God is working and we are thrilled to be a part of his plan.
